Dr. Sequeira is Associate Professor and past Residency Program Director of the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Western, and is a consultant physiatrist at St. Joseph's Health Care and in the Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation Programs at Parkwood Hospital, where he also runs a spasticity clinic and outpatient brain and spinal cord injury clinics.

Dr. Sequeira completed his undergraduate medicine degree at the University of Toronto in 1994 and went on to complete residency training in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Albany Medical Center in 1998. He completed a fellowship in Electrodiagnostic and Sport Medicine at Michigan State University the following year. He is a Clinical Electromyographer.

Dr. Sequeira is a past Director of the undergraduate Musculoskeletal curriculum at Western's medical school and has received a Dean's award of Excellence for undergraduate medical education. He was previously responsible for the integration of WSIB education into the medical school curriculum at Western.
